ABCs of Fall Makeup Trends--Femininity Rules!

- A. The return of semi-matte skin is hot for fall—a modern twist of sheer and matte makeup with gorgeous effect.

Skin preparation is important, so start with a moisturizer specific for your skin type. Then apply mineral powder using a brush (the brush is the key so you get a thin layer). Then add more to desired coverage. Use a highlighting pen or highlighting powder to add luminosity to tops of cheek bones, brow bone and the center of the upper lip.



- B. The quickest and least expensive way to change your look is lipstick!

Lips are elegant and defined in sweet pinks or deep chocolate. First, exfoliate your lips once a week as this helps your lipstick go on smoother. To get the color from the tube to look the same on your lips, apply concealer to even out the undertones. This also helps erase your lip line so you can create fuller or thinner lips. Choose a lip liner that is close to your chosen lip shade. Once you've outlined your lips, be sure to blend inward so that when your lipstick wears off, you aren't left with just an outline!

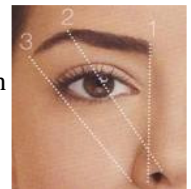


Added Suggestion: Add fullness to your lips with lip liner. First create a fresh canvas by erasing your existing lip line with concealer. Then using a natural-toned lip pencil, draw a line just *slightly* above and below your natural lip line on the top and around the bottom. (Don't exaggerate the line!) Next, use the lip liner to fill in lips *with the exception of the very center of your top and bottom lip*. When you next apply your lipstick, this area will remain lighter and help make your lips appear fuller. To finish, apply a light, shimmery lip gloss to the center of your lips over lipstick to help your lips appear even fuller.

- C. Brows with natural shapes and arches were all over the catwalks.

Just like your hair frames your face, your brows frame your eyes. Tweeze your brows to give them a precise, natural shape. A great idea is to see your favorite stylist for guidance. To determine this on your own, start with the three pivotal points along your brow line:

- Point 1: Hold a pencil vertically against the side of your nose, noticing where your brow should begin.
- Point 2: Hold the pencil against your nostril and move it diagonally across the outer half of the iris. Notice where the pencil meets the brow. This is the best place for the peak of your arch.
- Point 3: Again, place pencil against your nostril and extend it diagonally to the outer corner of your eye. Where it meets the brow is the best place for your brow to end.
